



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, June 17, 2022, marks the 17th annual National Dump the Pump Day as a day that encourages people to ride public transportation, as public transit offers economic opportunity, powers community growth, and offers an affordable and environmentally friendly option for transportation; and

WHEREAS, every \$1 invested in public transportation generates approximately \$5 in economic returns; and

WHEREAS, a household can save nearly \$10,000 by taking public transportation and be 10 times safer per mile than traveling by automobile; and

WHEREAS, communities that invest in public transit reduce the nation's carbon emissions by 63 million metric tons annually, helping to improve the environment and quality of life.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Linda Morse, Mayor of the City of Manhattan, Kansas, do hereby proclaim June 17, 2022, as

National Dump the Pump Day

in the city of Manhattan, and that the Flint Hills Area Transportation Agency will join with public transportation agencies across the country and participate in the 17th annual National Dump the Pump Day to encourage people to ride public transportation. Where public transportation goes, communities grow and prosper.
